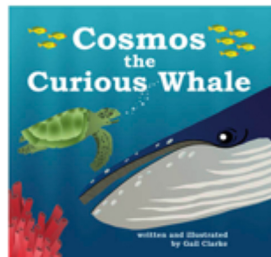
Patrick's Birthday Message
