Overview

On September 8, 2015, Discovery College donated 2 libraries located in Yutian County, Hebei Province. This donation completion report is for the library donations to Sunjianquan Central Elementary School and Dapanlong Elementary School.

For this donation, Discovery College donated 1,750 Chinese language children books, 9 bookshelves, 5 tables, 27 chairs, 2 globes, 1,750 book checkout cards, 2 sets of training materials, 2 CD/Tape recorders, 3 sets of artwork package, 2 donation signs and 1 comprehensive librarian training courses.

After the ceremony, TLP staff and the students read books together, played games, took photos and had fun together. It was really an unforgettable experience both for the students and us.

The Library Project Overview

Our Mission

The Library Project donates libraries to under financed schools and orphanages in China. We believe education is the key motivator to breaking the cycle of poverty that exists in the developing world. As we see it, education is change.

How we do it?

The Library Project accomplishes this by; getting the local community involved through book drives and awareness raising, providing books and libraries to under financed orphanages and elementary schools, and partnering with local NGOs (charities) and companies.

About Our Goals and Results

To date, The Library Project has provided over 1250 libraries to rural elementary schools and orphanages in China. Our goal is to develop The Library Project into an organization that helps empower millions of children every year through the gift of education. This goal will take an enormous amount of dedication, planning, and hard work. Thank you for your support.

About the Books

The Library Project provides a wide range of children's books that include: history, science, short stories, fairy tales, books for very young readers, children's dictionaries, children's reference books, and an assortment of comic books. Schools also receive a full set of children's encyclopedias. Most books are in full color and all are of the highest quality. 100% of the books are in the Chinese language and are published in China.

About Our Libraries

The Library Project provides colorful "child safe" furniture for elementary school libraries. The Library Project never constructs buildings; we only use the elementary school's available space. This space is utilized in two ways: as a Reading Room or a Reading Corner.

Reading Corners

A Reading Corner is a small bookshelf that sits in the corner of a small elementary school. This library solution is perfect for schools that lack a room that can be dedicated to a Reading Room. The Library Project also paints the walls, tables and benches of the classroom that acts as the school's library.



This option generally goes into smaller schools with student numbers of less than 100 students.

Reading Rooms

A Reading Room is a fun place for children to enjoy reading. Colorful tables, chairs, bookshelves and posters decorate this “child safe” area. This option generally goes into larger schools with student numbers of over 100 students.

Our Programs

Providing educational infrastructure in China is both challenging and rewarding. It takes planning, cultural competency, and logistical management to physically get the job done. The Library Project has developed three programs to help children gain the gift of education.

Elementary School Program

We provide libraries to rural elementary schools in China. We provide shelving, furniture, and floor mats depending on a school’s need. Although many local schools have some of these infrastructural items, they often lack the books to put on the shelves or have books so old that they are falling apart.

Orphanage Program

We establish libraries for small orphanages in China. These libraries are filled with colorful Chinese language books that are either purchased in China or acquired through local community based book-drives. The reading area is designed to be a safe and accessible place for children to feel comfortable and to nurture their educational curiosities. Colorful posters, games, furniture, and floor mats make the orphanage libraries an inviting and happy place for the children to learn and grow.

Legal Information

The Library Project is a registered 501c3 charity with the IRS in the USA. The Library Project has partnered with the China Population Welfare Foundation to provide libraries to rural elementary schools in China.
