Auditions will be held from Monday 12 January to Friday 16 January 2015. Interested students are required to email Mr. Davis ***no later than Monday 5 January 2015.*** The audition times will be shared with students on a googledoc by 7 January 2015.

Please be aware that all music accompaniments must be live and no recorded backing tracks. If you require accompaniment please bring your accompaniment music to the audition. Please note the accompanist is not needed for the audition.

The College will provide a piano accompanist for the evening performance and times will be made available for rehearsals. Parents are welcome to be the accompanist for their own children. Parents are asked not to organise their own accompanists and the College will not be remunerating accompanists organised by parents. The music department is aware that some pieces may be best suited accompanied by an instrument other than the piano. In such cases, please make contact with Mr. Davis to discuss the accompaniment.

On the evening, all students will be required to perform in appropriate concert dress and will be expected to be at the College at 5.00pm to warm up and tune.
